

Moses the Prophet—Genesis 1-27

1. Moses was a prophet. Deut 34:10
 - a) Moses wrote prophetically. Luke 24:44
 - b) Moses wrote about Jesus. John 1:45
 - c) Moses wrote the Pentateuch—Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy
2. Genesis Prophecy
 - a) Genesis 2:17 Man would eat and sin, thus the consequence. Fulfilled Gen 3
 - b) Genesis 3:15 Coming Sin Delivering Seed of the Woman F Hebrews 2:14-15
 - c) Genesis 6:13-22 Coming flood and safety in the ark F Gen 7:11, 8:18
 - d) Genesis 12:1-3 Abraham a blessing to all peoples. F Jewish nation and the blessing of Jesus. Gal 3:8, 9:14 Still in effect, land for the Jews and blessing and curses upon those who bless and curse the Jews.
 - (1) Gen.12:7 Abraham's descendants to have a land. F Joshua 1:1-4
 - (2) Gen. 15:4-5 Abraham to have an heir. F Gen 21:1-5
 - (3) Gen. 15:13-16 A lapse of time before the inheritance of the land. F Exodus 12:40-41, Gen 45:7:13
 - (4) Gen. 15:18-21 God's covenant of the land with Abraham. F Joshua 1:1-4 Still Gen 13:15, 17:8, detail a larger possession which belongs to the Jews.
 - e) Genesis 16:11-12 Ishmael (God hears) prophesied. F Gen 16:15-16, 21:21.
 - f) Gen. 17:20 God promises to bless Ismael. F Gen 25:5-6 Sons of Keturah and Hagar. Gen 25:13-18
 - g) Genesis 17 Isaac's birth foretold (19, 21) F Gen 21:1-5

- h) Genesis 22 Isaac the willing sacrifice (2-14) 22:18 the blessing of Messiah's sacrifice for all. F On Moriah, a large rock, called Rock of the Foundation (Jew's name).
- (1) Abram calls this place "the Mount of the Lord" Gen 22:14.
 - (2) The First and Second Temples were located here. 2 Chr 3:1
 - (3) David built an altar on Mt. Moriah. 1 Chr 21:18-25 Both David and Abraham were instructed of God to go there. It is God's designated place. Mount of the Lord=Temple Mount. North, the highest point is Golgotha.
- i) Genesis 24:60 Blessing of Rebecca similar to Isaac's blessing in 22:16-17
- j) Genesis 25:23 Israel to dominate Edom. F Gen 36:2-3 Canaanite nations, Joshua the Canaanite conquest.
- k) Genesis 26:3-5, 24 God's covenant with Isaac. F Many Jewish people today. Still to come, possession of all the land.
- l) Genesis 27:27-29 Blessing of Jacob by Isaac. Prominence of Isaac's descendants. F The nations bringing tribute to Israel under David and Solomon. 1 Kings 4:21
- m) Genesis 27:39-40 Isaac's prophecy of Edom. Would be in subjection to Israel, but one day cast off that rule. F 2 Kings 8:20-22 Edom's revolt against Israel.
- (1) Gen 36:11-12 Amalek is a grandson of Esau.
 - (2) 1 Samuel 15:3 God commanded Saul to destroy the Amalekites.
 - (3) 2 Sam 8:13-14 Aram=Edom, David conquered them and subdued them.
 - (4) 1 Kings 11:14-22, 25 Hadad bucked against Solomon's rule.

- n) Genesis 28:3-4 Transfer of the covenant of Abraham to Jacob by Issac.
 - (1) God promising it to Jacob. Gen 28:10-22
 - (2) Genesis 31:13 The call to return to the land of Canaan.
 - (3) F Gen 33:18-20 Jacob living in the land.
- o) Genesis 35:6-7, 9-15 God's promise of a land to Jacob. F Joshua 1:1-4
- p) Genesis 37:1-11 Joseph's prophetic dream of his rule. F Gen 42:6, 9
- q) Genesis 40:5-22 Joseph's interpretation of dreams. F
- r) Genesis 41:25-32 Joseph's interpretation of Pharaoh's dream. F Gen 41:46-49, 53-57
- s) Genesis 46:1-4 God's blessing upon Jacob in going to Egypt. He would bring them back again. F Ex1:7, 12, 3:8-10
- t) Genesis 48:14-20 The inclusion and blessing of Ephraim over Manasseh. F Hosea 4:17 As the lead tribe of Israel (Northern Kingdom), God judges.
- u) Genesis 49:1-27 Blessings of the tribes of Israel.
 - (1) Gen 49:7 Levi and Simeon scattered among the tribes. F Joshua 19:1,9; 13:14
 - (2) Gen 49:10 Messiah F Luke 1:32-33
